Exhibitor Lounge

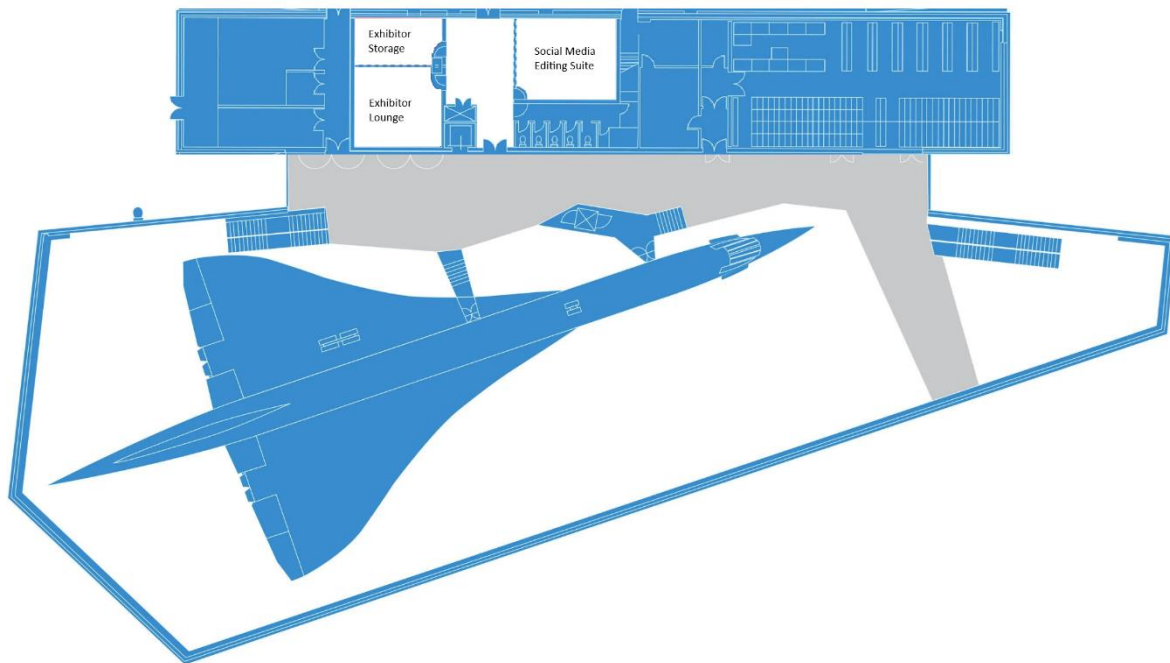

A quiet room for our official media partners. It will also be available for exhibitors if they require somewhere quiet.

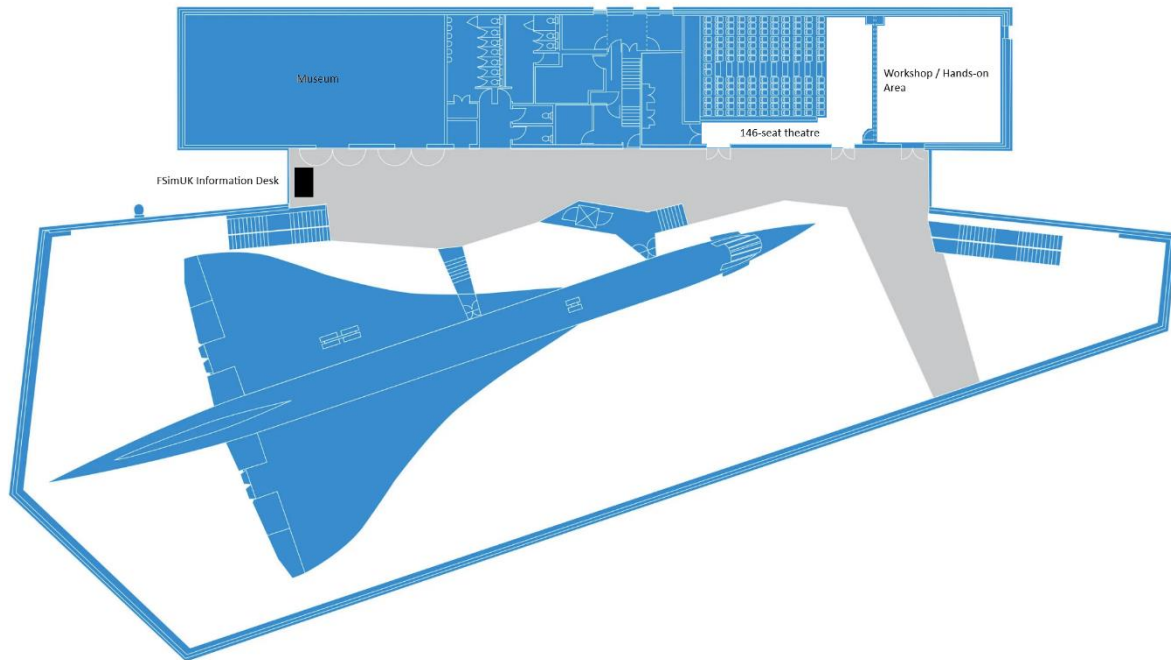

Concorde Hangar Upper Level

The mezzanine floor accommodates a theatre which will be utilised for presentations. Behind the theatre is a workshop area for exhibitors to run a hands-on event.

This level will also accommodate the FSimUK Information Desk.



From this level, visitors will be able to walk through Concorde. Access to the aircraft will be available throughout the weekend.



Aerospace Gallery

The Aerospace Gallery will accommodate 4 of the UK regional flight simulation groups running landing challenges, as detailed by red boxes D, E, F & G on the plan below.

FSimUK will issue goody bags and pre-ordered FSimUK t-shirts from the blue box A, on the plan below.



The Making Studio is reserved for two not-for-profit organisations who require specific space and arrangements.



Booth Sizes

The following sizes are offered:

- Small Stand: Up to 1.8m x 1.2m (6' x 4') – £25.00
- Medium Stand: Up to 10m² – £50.00
- Large Stand: Up to 20m² – £100.00
- Not for Profit (NfP) Stand – £0.00

Those opting for a **Medium Stand** will be asked via the online Exhibitor Registration for the size of your stand, up to a maximum of 10m². Medium Stands or booths should be designed to be accessible from one side only (e.g. the front).

Those opting for a **Large Stand** will be asked for the size of your stand up to a maximum of 20m². Large stands or booths can be designed to be accessible from one or two sides only. This constraint is due to the limited space available within the Concorde hangar.

Not for Profit stands will be allocated according to space available. These will likely be Small Stands (1.8m x 1.2m). If you require larger please state this on the Exhibitor Registration form.

FSimUK organisers kindly ask that you do not book for more space than required. We are expecting high volumes of exhibitors and anticipate challenges designing a floor layout.

Tables

FSimUK can provide standard 6' by 2' 6" wide (1.83m x 0.76m) tables. The Exhibition Registration form will ask you whether you require tables.

Chairs

Chairs, if required, will be readily available.



Meeting Space

During the show, you can book a meeting room above the Making Studio for your company, club, group, or virtual airline.

Booking arrangements are as follows:

Your group can have the room entirely to yourselves for one hour. You can book slots on both Saturday and Sunday. You can choose from 12 total slots across the weekend, running hourly from 10:30 to 16:30.

We ask that you leave the room on time so the next booking can start promptly.

Extend Slots: You may be able to book longer sessions if extra slots are available.

Exhibitor Tickets

Each individual exhibitor will need to purchase their own entrance ticket to Aerospace Bristol. These are separate from your exhibition donation and cost £20 per adult (online price includes 10% discount compared to £22 if purchasing on the day) which will give you free visitor access to Aerospace Bristol for 12 months from your ticket start date. Existing Aerospace Bristol annual passes, still in date, will be valid for the event.

We recommend you start your ticket on the 09th October 2026 if purchasing directly from the Aerospace Bristol website, to cater for setup time.

Presentations



The *John James Bristol Foundation* theatre at Aerospace Bristol can accommodate 146 people. It will be operated for FSimUK 2026 as the *FSElite Stage*.

Priority for presentation slots will be given to sponsors. However, you do not need to be exhibiting or be a sponsor, all submissions are welcome.

Prizes

Venue Location

Aerospace Bristol is located on Hayes Way, adjacent to the historic Filton Airfield, where every British Concorde made its maiden flight.

Please note that Aerospace Bristol's post code does not take you to the exact location of the museum, so we suggest you check [Google Maps](#) before setting out. Alternatively, you can pinpoint our exact location using [what3words](#) - search [pilots.factories.chew](#) to find the museum entrance.

Getting to the Venue

There are brown signs along three routes:

- From M5 junction 16
- From M5 junction 17
- Along the A38 from the Filton Roundabout (by the Air Balloon pub)

As Hayes Way is a dual carriageway, the museum can only be accessed from one side of the road. If approaching from M5 junction 17 (past Cribbs Causeway), you will pass the museum and need to turn around at the roundabout. If approaching from the A38, you will be on the correct side of the road and will only need to turn around if you miss the gate. **The entrance to the museum is on Hayes Way, just after the Lidl supermarket.**

Parking at Aerospace Bristol

Aerospace Bristol is **not** within Bristol's Ultra Low Emission Zone (ULEZ).

Aerospace Bristol offers free parking for all visitors and event guests, however, as a charity, they rely on public support. There are two donation points situated in the car park. Kindly consider giving a small donation to help maintain free outdoor facilities, including the car park and special aeroplane playground.



Car

We encourage exhibitors to car share wherever possible.

From M5 Junction 17:

- Exit the M5 at junction 17 and follow signs for The Mall
- Pass The Mall on your left and continue in the direction of Filton
- At the third roundabout, after passing the entrances to The Mall on your left, take the third exit towards Filton Bristol (A38) along Hayes Way
- Go straight over the next two roundabouts
- At the third roundabout, take the third exit so that you are returning in the direction you came. Aerospace Bristol is on your left, just after Lidl supermarket.

From M5 Junction 16:

- Exit the M5 at junction 16 and follow the A38 (Gloucester Road) in the direction of Filton
- Go straight across the first roundabout (2nd exit) continuing along the A38 (Gloucester Road)
- After approximately 1.5 miles, turn right onto Hayes Way by the Travelodge in the direction of Charlton Hayes and The Mall
- At the roundabout, take the first exit and continue along Hayes Way. Aerospace Bristol is on your left, just after Lidl supermarket.

From Bristol city centre:

- Continue north along Gloucester Road until you reach the Filton roundabout
- Go straight across heading along Gloucester Road North, passing Filton Airfield and the Royal Mail on your left
- After the flyover, take the left junction before the Travelodge in the direction of The Mall, M5 South and Charlton Hayes
- At the roundabout, take the first exit and continue along Hayes Way. Aerospace Bristol is on your left, just after Lidl supermarket.

From South Wales:

- Cross over the River Severn taking either the Prince of Wales Bridge or the Severn Bridge and continue until the M4 and M48 merge into the M4, and then take the lane marked South West M5 towards Bristol
- Continue along the slip road towards the M5 but remain in the left-hand lane
- Exit the M5 at junction 16 and follow the A38 (Gloucester Road) in the direction of Filton
- Go straight across the first roundabout (2nd exit) continuing along the A38 (Gloucester Road)
- After approximately 1.5 miles, turn right onto Hayes Way by the Travelodge in the direction of Charlton Hayes and The Mall



- At the roundabout, take the first exit and continue along Hayes Way. Aerospace Bristol is on your left, just after Lidl supermarket.

Public Transport

Train

Our nearest major railway station is Bristol Parkway, just 2.1 miles away and from there you'll find bus or taxi services to bring you to Aerospace Bristol. For details of train services to Bristol Parkway, please visit the [National Rail](#) or [GWR](#).



International Travel

The nearest airports to Aerospace Bristol are:

- Bristol Airport
- Birmingham Airport
- Heathrow Airport
- Gatwick Airport

From Bristol (BRS) Airport

Rental Car / Taxi:

Take the A38 north directly through Bristol, or use the A370 and M5 North (exit Junction 16 or 17). The drive takes roughly 30 to 45 minutes depending on traffic.

From Birmingham Airport (BHX)

By Train:

Take the free "Air-Rail Link" monorail from the terminal to Birmingham International station. Board a direct CrossCountry Trains service to Bristol Parkway (approximately 1 hour 20 minutes).

Rental Car:

Drive south on the M5 directly from Birmingham. Exit at Junction 16, follow the A38 south towards Filton, and follow the brown museum signs onto Hayes Way.

From London Heathrow Airport (LHR)

By Train:

Board the Elizabeth Line or the Heathrow Express to London Paddington. Switch to a Great Western Railway (GWR) train heading straight to Bristol Parkway (the nearest major rail hub to the museum). The train ride takes about 1 hour 15 minutes from Paddington.

From London Gatwick Airport (LGW)

By Train:

Take a direct Great Western Railway train from Gatwick Airport station to Reading. At Reading, cross the platform to board a high-speed train to Bristol Parkway. Total journey time is roughly 2.5 to 3 hours.



Eurostar or Channel Tunnel

Option 1: Via Eurostar (Foot Passengers)

This is the fastest and most sustainable option from Europe.

Step 1: Arrive at London St Pancras International

- **Route:** Board the Eurostar from your departure station in Europe. All cross-channel passenger trains terminate at London St Pancras International.
- **Travel Time:** Paris to London takes about 2 hours 15 minutes; Brussels takes roughly 2 hours.

Step 2: Transfer to London Paddington Station

You must cross London to reach the train line serving the West of England.

- **By Underground (Tube):** Follow the signs at St Pancras to the Underground station. Take the westbound Circle Line or Hammersmith & City Line directly to London Paddington.
- **Travel Time:** The Tube journey takes about 15 minutes.

Step 3: Train from London Paddington to Bristol Parkway

- **Route:** Board a high-speed Great Western Railway (GWR) train bound for Bristol Parkway.
Note: Ensure you book to Bristol Parkway, not Bristol Temple Meads, as Parkway is much closer to the museum.
- **Travel Time:** Approximately 1 hour 15 minutes.

Step 4: Final Leg to Aerospace Bristol

- **By Taxi:** A taxi or rideshare from Bristol Parkway to the museum takes about 5 to 10 minutes.

If you prefer to bring your own vehicle from Europe, you will use Le Shuttle service running from Calais, France to Folkestone, UK.

Step 1: Cross the Channel

- **Crossing Time:** The crossing to Folkestone takes 35 minutes. Remember that driving switches to the left side of the road immediately upon exiting the UK terminal!

Step 2: Drive from Folkestone to Bristol

The driving route is almost entirely on major motorways:

1. From Folkestone, take the M20 motorway heading west toward London.
2. Join the M25 (London Orbital Motorway) heading northbound/westbound towards Heathrow.
3. Exit the M25 at Junction 15 to join the M4 motorway heading west toward Wales/Bristol.
4. Leave the M4 at Junction 19 (M32/Bristol) or Junction 20 (Almondsbury Interchange/M5). Follow the signs for the A38 / Filton.



5. As you near Filton, follow the brown tourism signs for Aerospace Bristol onto Hayes Way.
- Driving Time: Approximately 3 to 3.5 hours from Folkestone, depending on London motorway traffic.
 - Parking: Parking at Aerospace Bristol is completely free for museum visitors.
